

Geelong HOG Overnight Club Ride



We have arranged an overnight ride for members and partners on the weekend after Easter.

Dates: **Saturday 10th & Sunday 11th April 2010**

The ride departs from Texas Café in Mercer Street Geelong at 9:00AM on the Saturday.

Our destination is the Wannon River Holiday Park.

The weekend will initially be restricted to members and partners. Should member interest not be great, we will open up the ride to friends of members and other HOG Clubs to meet the numbers.

Saturday will be a fairly full day of riding with close to six hours on the bike (refer map below). We will take breaks at Lorne, Apollo Bay, Port Campbell (lunch) and Warrnambool.

Accommodation is to be at the Wannon River Holiday Park where we have reserved the 21 cabins available. Cabins include a mix of bed configurations with the price varying according to the number that a cabin sleeps (between \$50 and \$70). You can reserve a cabin on a first come first serve basis by contacting Dale Doonan to confirm your attendance and paying \$20 per cabin reservation fee (the remainder of the accommodation charge is due on arrival). The Saturday night meal will be BBQ with a few quiet drinks. This is being arranged through local contacts with prices at cost and kept low by purchasing from the local Supermarket.

Sunday is an easier day of riding with 1.5 hours to Derrinallum and slightly more than an hour from their to Geelong. Sunday lunch will be a spit roast at the Derrinallum Bowling Club with drinks at bar prices. We will also spend a couple of hours playing lawn bowls.
